The Spay/Neuter Program is designed for those individuals in Onondaga County who are considered low income, (Medicaid, SSI, HEAP, or other Public Assistance). We are currently offering these services Wednesdays and Thursdays by appointment only. Low Income Spay Neuter:

Cats:

Male Cat Neuter: \$65

Male Cat Cryptorchid Neuter: \$80

Cryptorchidism is the absence of one or both testes from the scrotum.

Female Cat Spays: \$90

DOGS:

Male Dog Neuter \$95

Male Dog Cryptorchid Neuter \$150

Female Dog Spay:

Less than 20 lbs: \$135

21-35 lbs: \$145

36-50lbs: \$155

51-75lbs: \$165

76-100 lbs: \$175

For every 25lbs over 100 add \$20

We do not spay animals' in-heat. If your animal is in-heat or you know when your animals last cycle was please inform the staff when making the appointment. We will Spay Pregnant females.

All surgeries include a physical exam, ear cleaning and nail trimming.

All animals are required to have a rabies vaccine. Please provide proof of rabies vaccine (rabies certificate from clinic or veterinarian or rabies tag). If no rabies vaccine proof is provided please add \$5 for vaccination.

We only accept **cash or money order**. All fees due when dropping off the animal for surgery.

No food after midnight the night before, water is ok.

Drop off between 7:30 – 8:00 am the day of surgery. Pick up between 4pm – 6pm the day of surgery.

If flea treatment is requested there will be a mandatory Heart worm testing.
